

Minutes of Meeting held on 1st February, 2021 at 12.30 pm to 2.00 pm.

The Principal began the Meeting by congratulating Dr. Anandan Priya for award of 'Highly Appreciated' paper presented in the Seminar organized by the Government College, Pernem.

Examination:

Principal instructed the TY teachers to record the TY exam marks on the Mark Sheet and also on the Answer Book, later on it will be uploaded on GUMS portal. He also added that marking on answer sheets is needed during personal verification

Students who have missed exam due to COVID symptoms reasons will be given another chance.

Speaking about offline classes, the Principal said that not more than 50% of the (subject with) practical classes shall be taken on offline.

Dr. Elizabeth raised a question on workability of the practical classes. Principal told let us workout once we receive circular from university.

Dr. Kissan, Exam Committee Convenor, gave details of the Examination. He said that Backlog exam was conducted in the month of December, 2020. A total of 191 students appeared out of which 19 students failed. Marks statement were issued for the same.

The results for the Exam conducted on 4th January 2021, will be put up on 3rd February, 2021. He added that for the First semester 128 students appeared out of which there were 23 failures and for the Third semester, 103 students appeared out of which there were 8 failures.

Dr Kissan said that the TY exam was conducted in offline mode and gave details about the exam conducted, the SOPs followed etc.

Program of the month:

The Principal said that Mr. Siddesh will be Incharge for the 30 hours free Training organized by the Presidency College of Hotel Management Bengaluru for frontline jobs from 3rd February, 2021. He asked the faculty to motivate students to register formally.

Dr. Fatima, HOD Commerce Department, informed that the Department is organising a Seminar on NEP On 13th March, 2021 and informed about funds collection for their


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Seminar. She has also planned a program with Alumni Association for students as part of Decennial Year Celebrations.

Ms. Vinita said that the NSS volunteers are conducting a survey on post-Polio vaccination.

Dr. Elizabeth informed that the Economics Department has planned a webinar on the topic of 'Career in Banking' for students, an Inter Collegiate essay competition on 8th March, 2021 as part of Women's Day celebration, and a Talk on Tourism.

Principal mentioned that the maintenance of invertors to be done and 3 new water filters have been fixed before TY offline exam. The Library is going to get five new PCs. The NSS head office has not settled the bills for the past 3 years after several reminders.

Dr Elizabeth raised question on quality of internet in the College as classes are going to commence on 8th February 2021. Principal replied that currently the GBBN Connectivity is of 20 points. JIO people repaired WIFI connectivity two days back..

A query on salary bills of Visiting faculty being pending was raised during the Meeting. Principal told, he will find out where it is held up and inform you soon.

Dr. Elizabeth as NAAC Convenor, said that there is a lot of data discrepancy in the data given by Office and the AISHE data. There should be a system where data from office is verified and provided to the NAAC criteria Incharges. She also enquired about Ms. Vinita's criteria for visually impaired and colour-blind etc., to which Dr.Kissan said it will be installed soon.


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
