20th March 2025 MEET THE ENTREPRENEUR- LECTURE SERIES IX



4th April 2025 EDUCATIONAL FIELD TRID

The Department of Environmental Studies organized an enriching **One-Day Field Trip** for FY B. Com and B.Sc. students to Mollem Biodiversity Park and Satpal Arboretum in Mollem Goa.

The objective was to connect students with nature and promote awareness of biodiversity and conservation practices. A total of 86 students, accompanied by 12 teaching and non-teaching staff, participated in this educational At the Mollem experience. Biodiversity Park, situated in the Bhagwan Mahavir heart of Wildlife Sanctuary, students experienced a rich variety of flora.



They observed endemic and

endangered plant and insect species, medicinal herbs. The visit highlighted the role of biodiversity parks in ex-situ conservation, climate regulation, and ecosystem preservation.

The group later visited the Satpal Arboretum, a government-managed botanical area featuring both native and exotic trees. Students explored thematic sections such as the Swasthya Van, which connects trees to human health, and the Rashi Nakshatra Van, which associates specific trees with zodiac signs and birth stars. They also toured the cactus house and engaged in birdwatching and pollinator observation activities. Guided by knowledgeable faculty and a local forest expert, students gained valuable insights into Goa's forest ecosystems and the importance of ecological balance. The field trip was both informative and inspiring, reinforcing classroom learning through direct experience in nature.
