“Workshop on Open Book Learning and Assessment” 17th September 2024



A workshop on **Open Book Learning and Assessment** was organised by the Examination Committee in association with IQAC for the Teaching and Non Teaching staff of the College. The resource person for the same was Dr. Russell D'Souza, Assistant Professor (Selection Grade) at Nirmala Institute of Education, Panaji - Goa, Presently on deputation to the State Council of Educational Research Research and Training (SCERT), Government of Goa, Goa who was welcomed by the Principal Prof.(Dr.) F.M.Nadaf

The session focused on transitioning to Open Book Learning and Assessment. The resource person highlighted the limitations of traditional closed-book assessments, such as memorization over comprehension, high-pressure stakes, and limited evaluation of real-world skills. Key topics included micro-learning, metacognition, open-book learning's flexibility and real-world relevance, critical thinking, Bloom's Revised Taxonomy, and the design and implementation of effective open-book assessments. The workshop, attended by 27 participants, was activity-based, involving five tasks that emphasized application, reducing test anxiety, promoting higher-order thinking, and continuous improvement. The session concluded with a question-and-answer segment and a vote of thanks by Assistant Professor Ms. Stally Pereira. Ms. Rupali Vijay Sangodkar was the program coordinator. It was deemed highly informative and impactful in encouraging the adoption of open-book learning methods.



“Field Visit to the ICAR-Indian Council of Agricultural Research, Old Goa” 18th September 2024

The Department of Economics organised a field trip to the ICAR - Central Coastal Agricultural Research Institute, which focusses on developing sustainable farming practices, innovative agricultural technologies and crop management strategies that are specifically tailored to coastal ecosystems. The visit aimed to enhance the students’ understanding of agricultural practices and research in India and provide them a hands-on learning experience.

The students were familiarized with grafting techniques, various mango varieties grown in Goa, they



were introduced to intercropping practices, explored rice cultivation techniques, learning about traditional and observed cattle management practices modern practices, and were also made aware of hybrid breeds innovated at the ICAR in piggery. Overall, the field trip provided the students with valuable insights into agricultural research, reinforcing students' academic knowledge. The students also interacted with the Director of the ICAR

and were ably guided by Shri. Omkar Sawant, Young Professional at the ICAR.

"Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam" and "Plant 4 Mother Campaign" 18th September 2024

The event was graced by the Chief Guest, Dr. Sunny Kanekar, the College Director of Physical Education at Vidyaprabhoni College. 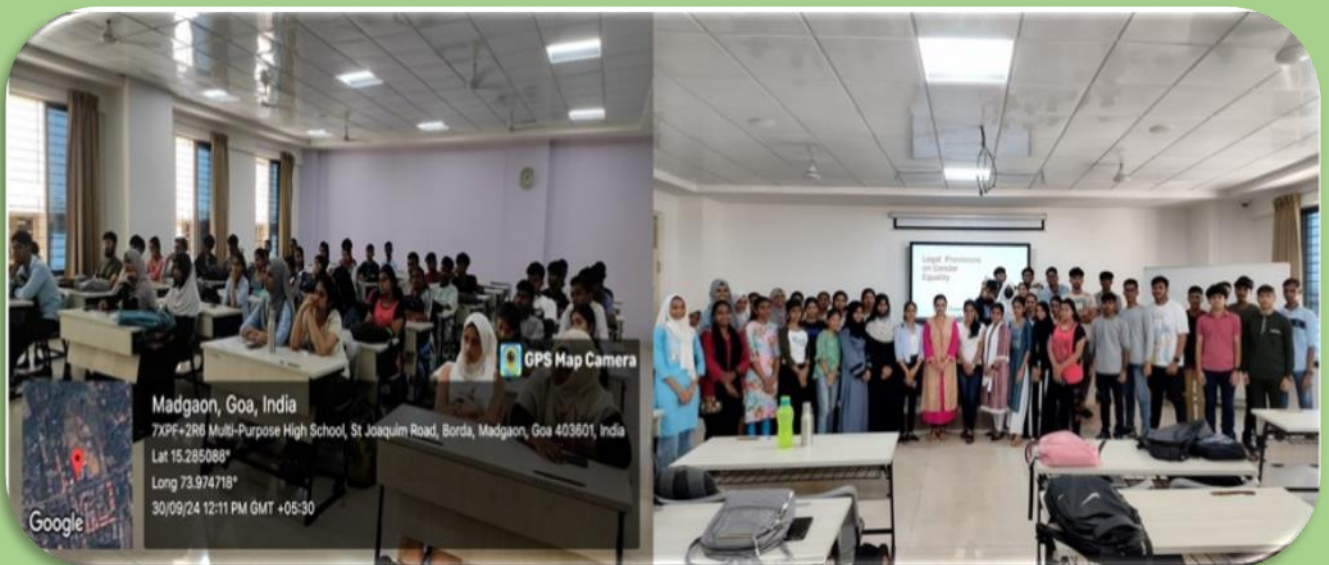
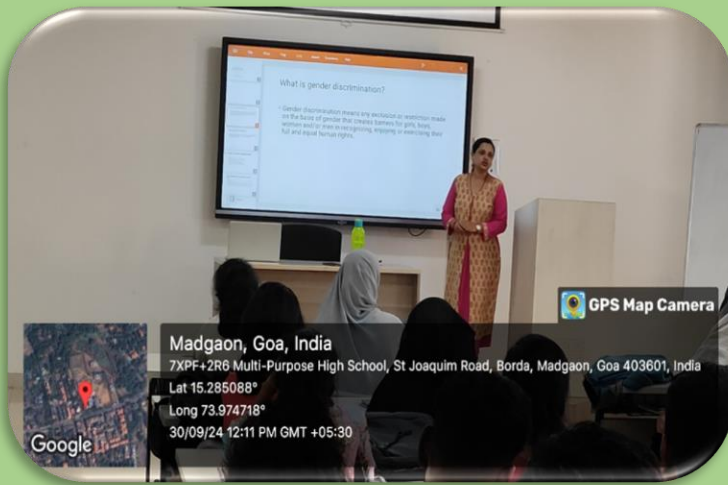
“Seminar on Legal Provisions on Gender Equality” 30th September 2024

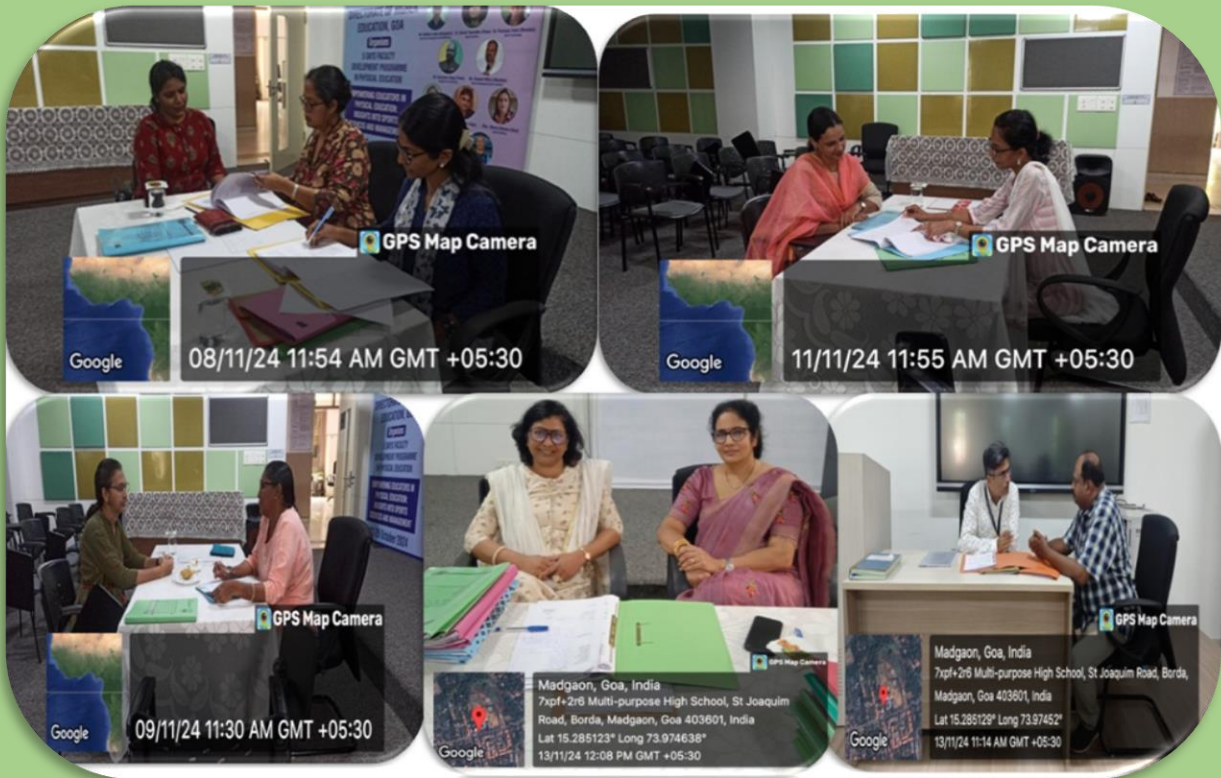
