OFFICE ORDER

Student Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC) for the Academic Years 2026-27 to 2027-28

In pursuance of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Regulations for Redressal of Grievances of Students, 2023 (Notification dated 11th April 2023), the Students' Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC) is hereby constituted for the Government of Goa's College of Multidisciplinary Studies & Research, Margao-Goa, for the period 2026-27 to 2027-28.

The Committee shall consider and redress the grievances of students in accordance with the provisions of the UGC Regulations.

The Committee shall comprise the following members:

Terms and Functions

1. The term of the Chairperson and Members shall be two years (Academic Years 2026-27 to 2027-28).
2. The term of the Special Invitee shall be one year or until a new General Secretary of the Students' Council assumes office, whichever is earlier.

3. The quorum for the meetings of the Committee, including the Chairperson but excluding the Special Invitee, shall be **three members**.
4. While considering grievances, the Committee shall adhere to the **principles of natural justice** and the provisions of the **UGC Regulations for Redressal of Grievances of Students, 2023**.
5. The Committee shall examine complaints received from students and submit its recommendations to the **Principal**. A copy of the recommendations shall also be communicated to the aggrieved student, preferably within **15 working days** from the date of receipt of the complaint.
6. Any student aggrieved by the decision of the Students' Grievance Redressal Committee may prefer an appeal to the **Ombudsperson**, within **fifteen (15) days** from the date of receipt of the decision of the Committee, as provided under the UGC Regulations.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
