REPORT OF ONE DAY STATE LEVEL SEMINAR

ON

'Tax Planning and Investment Avenues for Salaried Class'

Government College of Commerce and Economics, Borda, organized a one day State Level Seminar on 'Tax Planning and Investment Avenues for Salaried Class,' at the Ravindra Bhavan, Margao, on 17th October 2016.

The Principal, Dr. Maria Fatima De Souza, welcomed the dignitaries and the delegates for the seminar. The welcome address was followed by the lighting of the traditional lamp.

Dr. Purva G. Hegde Desai, Chartered Accountant and Head Department of Management Studies, Goa University, was the Chief Guest & Key note speaker. In a very thought provoking keynote address, Dr. Purva G. Hegde Desai opened up on the theme of the seminar by stating that there are two distinct classes of tax payers, that is Government employees & non Government employees and highlighted that there is lack of opportunities in tax planning for Government employees as compared to non-Government employees. She also deliberated on need of revision of existing provisions of income tax laws relating to salaries.

Mr. Vishal Naik Assistant Prof. in commerce proposed the Vote of thanks and ended the formal inaugural programme.

Two technical sessions were conducted on the seminar theme. In the first one, titled 'Investment Avenue and Tax Saving Opportunities to Salaried class', Dr. Subramanyam Bhat enlightened the gathering on Form 16, the due dates to file TDS and the penalties involved in case of delay, the income slab assessment 2016-17 for men, women and senior citizens etc. He also spoke about various methods of tax planning like investing in Post Office savings, Public Provident fund, National Savings Certificate, KisanVikasPatra, Sukanya Savings scheme etc.

Mr. Bipin Bandekar, in the second technical session, titled 'Tax Computation and Planning for salaried class', spoke about tax planning. He explained the several steps in tax planning like Provision of Income Tax Act, Computation of Taxable Income, Computation of Tax Liability and Tax Planning.

The sessions were followed by panel discussion. The panelists were Mr. Pushparaj Patil, Assistant Joint Commissioner of Income Tax, South Goa, Income Tax Officers, South Goa, Ms.Bina Kumari and Mr.Gajinkar, the Principal, Dr. Maria Fatima De Souza and Mr. Bipin Bandekar. The panel discussion was chaired by Dr. Subramanyam Bhat. The panelists answered all income tax related queries of the audience. The seminar ended with a vote of thanks proposed by the Convenor, Mr. Mahesh M. Kerkar.
